- July and August are off limits. Just don't do it (unless you fancy being stuck in traffic in the agonising heat). Instead, go in May, June,
   September or October – when the weather is still warm, the traffic subsides and prices drop.
- Pretend you're living here for the week and rent a gîte (self-catering accommodation) - they range from charming villas to simple apartments. Check out <u>Gîtes de France</u> for the best selection of properties.
- You came here for the food, right? Whether you rent a gîte or not, the
  market is your best source of local specialities you'll find everything
  you need for that perfect picnic or simple dinner. Market days vary by
  town, but most only last until mid-afternoon make sure you ask
  about the closest food market (and its schedule) when you book your
  accommodation.
- If you've just gotta stay in a hotel, base yourself in <u>Marseille or Nice</u>.
   In Marseille, hit the tourist office for one of their free walking-tour maps the best one covers Le Panier, Marseille's boho district. In Nice, hit the curvy lanes of Vieux (Old) Nice and take in the

spectacular baroque architecture before going for a stroll along the famed Promenade des Anglais - come at sunset for unbeatable views of the sea and free people-watching entertainment.
